## Call for Papers

### EU Values in the Digital Ecosystem

**a.y. 2026-2027**

The Jean Monnet Chair "EU Values in the Online digital environment" of the Università degli Studi Roma Tre - Department of Political Science (Prof. Raffaele Torino) opens a call for papers announces, for the second year, a Call for Papers within the research activities of the Jean Monnet Chair.

#### **Context:**

The digital ecosystem in which we live presents new challenges to the fundamental values of the European Union, as set out in Art. 2 of the Treaty on European Union: human dignity, freedom, democracy, equality, the rule of law, human rights and the rights of persons belonging to minorities. The Working Papers should deepen the analysis and understanding of how these values are protected and promoted in the digital context, exploring the intersections between the interests of businesses, citizens and institutions.

In particular, the thematic areas of interest for this edition of the Working Papers include:

- **Personal data and artificial intelligence systems**
- **Alignment of artificial intelligence tools with European fundamental values**
- **Digital innovation and control of individuals**
- **Digital monopolies and consumer protection**
- **Digitalisation of public administration and respect for fundamental rights**
- **EU Digital Omnibus**
- **Artificial intelligence tools and digital education**

### **Target audience:**

The call is addressed to scholars, academics, researchers, professionals and experts aged 40 or under interested in the themes of the Jean Monnet Chair.

### **Submission and selection:**

Abstracts (maximum 300 words), accompanied by a brief curriculum vitae of the author (maximum 150 words), must be submitted by **15 April 2026** to the following email address: [evochair@uniroma3.it](mailto:evochair@uniroma3.it).

The selection of abstracts will be based on the quality of the abstract and its relevance to the themes of interest to the Jean Monnet Chair. The outcome of the selection of abstracts will be communicated to prospective authors no later than 1 June 2026.

If the abstract is selected, the author(s) will be invited to submit a working paper to be discussed during the hybrid workshop scheduled in **July 2026**. The aim of the hybrid workshop is to enable all contributors to receive initial feedback on their working papers. After the workshop, the author will have the opportunity to further improve his or her working paper before presenting the final paper.

As part of the publication process, authors undertake to submit the full paper by **15 November 2026**.

The final papers will be submitted to a review process by the Scientific Committee before being published on the Jean Monnet Chair website.

### **Publication:**

The selected papers will be invited to participate in a collective publication (scheduled to coincide with the final conference of the Chair) in the 'Studies for Political Science' Series of the Department of Political Science, Roma Tre-Press (Open Access publication, with DOI and SSN code).

On the other hand, the Scientific Committee will select some of the most innovative working papers for submission to national and international peer-review journals dealing with Jean Monnet Chair topics.
